



## YOUNG ADULT CAREER SYMPOSIUM IN THE WORKS

Preparations are well under way for the first Grand Boulé Young Adult Career Symposium, which is scheduled to take place June 27–29, 2008, at the Hyatt Regency Denver. The planning committee for the weekend event is pleased to report significant progress.

Grand Sire Archon Cornell Leverette Moore is the architect of the program, which will bring together the sons and daughters of Sigma Pi Phi members to help them succeed with confidence in any career. “I am excited about the potential of this symposium and the impact it will have on our next generation, and I am grateful to the many volunteers who are working to make this a grand success,” he said in a recent interview. The Grand Sire Archon’s fund-raising efforts are helping secure corporate sponsorships in an effort to underwrite the costs of the program. He hopes to confirm sponsorships before fall.

A letter from Grand Sire Archon Moore announcing the symposium was circulated to all member boulés in April and May. Included in the letter was a form that Archons can use to submit information about their children, who must be between the ages of twenty-four and thirty. The form, which appears in this issue, will also be distributed at the regional boulé meetings this summer and can be downloaded from the Boulé Web site. The contact information will be used to build a database of prospects that the Boulé can contact directly. As previously announced, one hundred participants are expected in the inaugural program. Every effort will be made to ensure that the participant pool reflects the Fraternity’s regional-membership pro-

file and has a balanced mix of men and women. Information about the application process will be distributed around November or December of this year.

According to Archousa Linda Keene, chairwoman of the symposium-planning committee, invitations have been extended to a number of distinguished African American men and women to participate in the symposium. Archousa Susan L. Taylor, editorial director of *Essence* magazine, has already been confirmed as a panelist for the workshop “Climbing the Organizational Ladder: A View From the Top.” As additional speakers are engaged, they will be announced in upcoming *Boulé Journal* articles and on the Sigma Pi Phi Web site.

Archousa Keene acknowledges the members of the planning committee, who are working hard to ensure that the symposium is a dynamic weekend that is both educational and fun.
