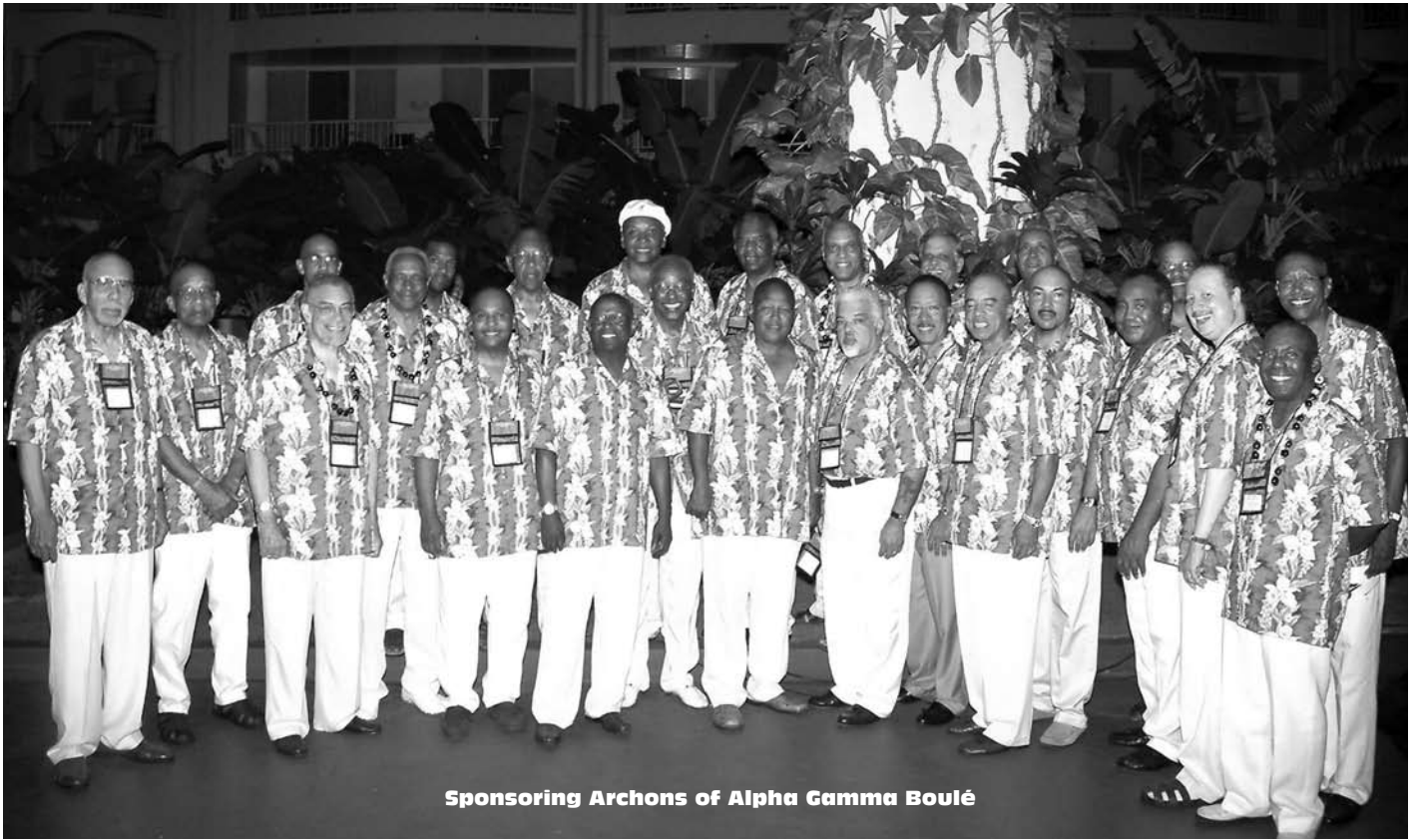


# The Regional Boulés
